

# ***Giant Bunting Commission for the Festival of Thrift 2016***

The Giant Bunting was commissioned for the Festival of Thrift in 2016 and was made by pupils from Saltburn Primary School, Huntcliffe Secondary School and Prior Pursglove College, working with Pauline Taylor from Infinite Arts.

The work involved participants in gathering clothes and fabrics which they were no longer using and upcycling them into collaged bunting. Each Triangle is over 1metre wide and about 1.5 metres long. When they were finally sewn together they form a long line of almost 40 flags stretching about 80 metres.

The flags have been exhibited twice at the walled garden in Kirkleatham Museum as part of the Festival. The first time they adorned the outer wall and in 2017, the flags were used on the inner wall of the garden.



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
